The John T. Brownlee Leadership Award is the Florida Association of Colleges & Employers' highest honor.

*Tim Harding currently serves as the Associate Dean of Career Development and Engagement at The University of Tampa in Tampa, FL, where he has been employed since August 2005. - Members of the selection committee are not eligible to nominate.
